



DIVORCED OR SEPARATED PARENTS:
OFFICE POLICIES

CUSTODIAL PARENT & CUSTODY AGREEMENTS: We require legal documentation to be submitted for all court-ordered custody agreements. If we do not have an up-to-date custody agreement on file, both biological parents have equal access to the patient's medical record, including the ability to schedule or cancel appointments, bring the patient to appointments, and assist in making medical decisions.

If parents have joint custody, we ask that *both* parents complete a HIPAA form specifying who Legacy Pediatrics is authorized to communicate with them regarding their child's medical care.

NOTIFICATION OF PRE-BOOKED OFFICE APPOINTMENTS: Unless otherwise stated in the custody agreement on file in the patient's chart, either parent may call the office at any time to ask if any appointments are scheduled for the patient. Our office will not call or notify one parent when an appointment is scheduled by the other parent.

ACCESS TO THE PATIENT PORTAL: Our patient portal allows electronic access to portions of the medical record. A consent form must be completed before a patient's portal account can be activated. Our electronic medical record system does not allow for more than 1 username or password. Therefore, if unable to come to a mutual agreement, we cannot provide either parent access to the patient portal.
