Birth	Hep B
2 mos	Pentacel, Hep B, Prevnar, Rotavirus (oral)
4 mos	Pentacel, Prevnar, Rotavirus (oral)
6 mos	Pentacel, Hep B, Prevnar, Rotavirus (oral)
9 mos	No shots, Hct and lead to be done (finger prick)
12 mos	Hepatitis A, MMR, Varivax
15 mos	Prevnar
18 mos	Pentacel, Hepatitis A
2 yrs	Hepatitis A (if not given at 18 month appt), lead level to be drawn
5 yrs	Quadracel (Dtap & IPV), MMR, Varivax
11 yrs	Tdap, Menactra, HPV, finger prick for lipid panel
12 yrs	HPV
13 yrs	none
14-17 yrs	none
16 yrs	Tdap, Menactra, Men B
17-18 yrs	Men B
18 yrs	finger prick for lipid panel, PPD if needed for college

Pentacel: HiB, diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, polio

Prevnar: Strep pneumoniae (13 strains)

MMR: Measles, Mumps, Rubella

Varivax: Varicella (chicken pox)

Dtap: Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis

IPV: Polio

Tdap: Tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis

Menactra: Meningitis (strains A, C, W, Y)

HPV: Human Papilloma virus

PPD: Skin test to show exposure to tuberculosis

Flu: Flu can be administered starting at 6 months of age and yearly thereafter

Men B: (Trumenba), Meningitis B

Hct: Hematocrit, check for anemia
